Our high-ohmic alloys are a vital element in a variety of the world's leading braking resistors, including specialized flat resistors designed for continual high-friction/high-temperature performance. Our alloys ISAOHM®, ISOTAN®, and ISA-CHROM (30, 60, and 80) are homogenous solid-solution alloys that are annealed and stabilized—resulting in outstanding long-term stability and guaranteeing a linear TCR and highly homogenous specific resistance over the entire spool.
